- Participate in the admission, transition, and discharge of clients, providing support to families.
- Administer curriculum-based, preference, functional, and other ABA assessments and analyses.
- Design teaching programs and behavior intervention plans for clients, monitoring and adjusting them as needed to ensure optimum treatment.
- Summarize and interpret ABA and/or IBI session data. Complete and maintain clinical records according to standards.
- Participate in clinical case review meeting and complete client progress reports as required (e.g. Individual Service Plans for DFO funding).
- Conduct parent meetings and regularly provide updates on treatment goals and strategies.
- Train staff on the implementation of teaching programs and behavior intervention plans, as well as on concepts related to ABA and the delivery of IBI.
- Supervise and mentor staff, providing timely feedback on their performance, and conducting team meeting, supervision meetings, and performance appraisals.

- Deliver ABA workshops and clinics for parents/caregivers (e.g. toileting clinic) and provide coaching as necessary.

The qualifications of the individual we are looking for include:

- Completion of, or working towards, the Board Certified Behaviour Analyst (BCBA) certification is a definite asset; or completion of the Board Certified Assistant Behaviour Analyst (BCaBA) certification
- A minimum of five years of experience in the delivery of ABA services
- Two or more years of experience with the clinical supervision of ABA/IBI programs is an asset
- Well-versed in the application of Applied Verbal Behaviour, Discrete Trial Teaching, Natural Environment Teaching, Pivotal Response Treatment, Group Instruction, and other ABA teaching strategies
- Experience with curriculum-based assessments, preference assessments, functional assessments and analyses
